Required Record Checks Prior to Volunteering

Prior to volunteering for field trips or other school activities including school sports, volunteers are required to submit a satisfactory and recent (within 6 months) record check. All checks must be originals or certified copies of the original. Check out Wild Rose School Division Administrative Procedure 490 - Volunteers for complete details.

 CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK (Including Vulnerable Sector Query)
How to apply: You must your letter from the school and two pieces of government issued identification (at least one must be a photo ID) to your local RCMP Detachment. Your ID must show that you reside in the same community as the Detachment.

Letters can be picked up at our office or emailed to ensure there is no cost to you. Please be advised there is a waiting period for the completion of this check.

Parent Drivers of students that are NOT your own child, MUST ALSO have on file a SATISFACTORY DRIVER'S ABSTRACT with proof of million-dollar liability.

Please contact the office to receive a letter of consent to fill out, we will send on your behalf, at no cost to you. Allow a couple weeks to get back.
