

Personal Mobile Devices In Schools

On June 17, 2024 the Minister of Education announced new restrictions on the use of personal mobile devices and access to social media platforms for children and students in Kindergarten to Grade 12 effective September 1, 2024. See the Ministerial Order and the Minister's Letter to Parents.

All school divisions in Alberta are required to have written Personal Mobile Device procedures in place by January 1, 2025.

In the meantime, Charlotte Small Elementary's current policy will comply with required regulations.

Charlotte Small Elementary Personal Mobile Device Policy:

"Students will not use personal mobile devices during instructional time. All device notifications must be turned off during instructional time and kept in lockers. Students are not permitted to take pictures/videos of others anywhere during a school event, including while on buses. Failure to comply with this policy will result in the device being stored at the office and parents will be required to retrieve the device at the school. Neither the school or Wild Rose School Division is responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal devices."

Why are these new Procedures being put in place?

Much research has been conducted in recent years showing that the increased use of personal mobile devices has resulted in the declining mental health of students and an increase in cyberbullying. As much as possible, please make arrangements with your child for the end of the day in the morning, before they leave for school. Please communicate with teachers directly if children are to be picked up by someone out of the ordinary, ride a different bus home, etc.




