Let's work together to build strong partnerships that support our students' growth and foster a love of learning. Your voice matters, and we are eager to hear your ideas and feedback.

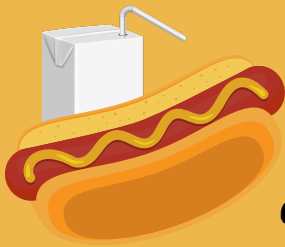

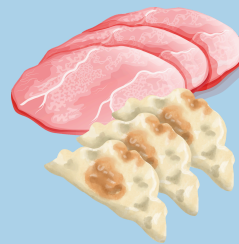
