Depart school at 9:15 am, Return by 12:00 pm. Students will eat lunch when they return to school.



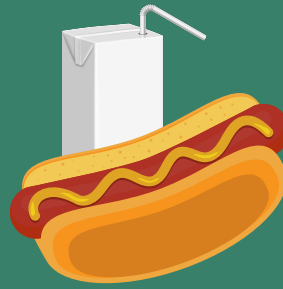
