ALLERGY AWARENESS

This year, we have students with severe, life-threatening allergies to nuts. For these students, exposure to nuts whether through ingestion or contact with surfaces contaminated by nut products — can result in a serious and potentially fatal allergic reaction. In order to provide a safe and inclusive learning environment for all students, we are asking for your cooperation in the following ways:

- Students in ECS, Grade 4, and Grade 5 should not bring any food items containing nuts or nut products to school. These classrooms have students with known severe allergies, and it is essential we maintain a nut-free environment in these spaces.
- For students in other grades, we ask that families avoid sending nut-containing items whenever possible. If your child does bring a food item that contains nuts, we ask that you notify their teacher, so appropriate precautions can be taken (e.g., handwashing, avoiding shared surfaces).

Additionally, we have a student with a severe allergy to horses. We ask families to be mindful of clothing or belongings that may have come into contact with horses. This includes horsehair on jackets, backpacks, and footwear.

We appreciate your continued support and understanding as we work together to make Charlotte Small Elementary a safe environment for all children.




